At Sefton Park Medical Centre we have remained open throughout the pandemic, providing new, safe, digital consultation solutions to ensure our patients continue to get the care they need.

This is what we have been doing over the 5 month period from April to September . . .



Our GPs have seen 751 patients face to face at the practice



Our GPs have conducted 7,177 video and telephone consultations



Our nurses have seen 934 patients face to face at the practice



Altogether we have visited 120 patients in their own home



989 eConsultations have been responded to by the admin and clinical team



78 patients have been referred to Secondary Care



533 Sick Notes have been issued



More than 72,000 prescription items have been issued



We have welcomed 420 new patients to our practice during this period



We even stayed open on bank holidays during lockdown to make sure we were there for our patients when they needed us

A big **“Thank You”** to the vast majority of our 8,500 patients who have been understanding with our new ways of working and the need to wear a face mask or covering when coming to the practice and the 99.4% of patients who have kept their appointment with us.
